

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP  
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD OCTOBER 15, 2013**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on October 15, 2013 for their regular monthly meeting in the township municipal building at 8:00 P.M.

Chairman, Chad Crawford called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Chad Crawford motioned, Hans Dahlin seconded to approve the September 9<sup>th</sup> 2013 minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Chad Crawford motioned, John Nicely seconded to approve the October 7, 2013 Work Session minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

**REPORTS:**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT:** Monthly report was not available.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:** Monthly report was available.

**ROAD DEPARTMENT:** Monthly report was available.

**ZONING OFFICER:** Jeff Frye stated firstly, he was unable to get in touch with Dr. Tsai regarding the status of the statue. Jeff remarked that it is to his understanding that Dr. Tsai is having difficulty obtaining an engineer to sign off on the drawings that state the statue is compliant with the state requirements.

Secondly, he stated he is moving forward toward issuing citations to the landowners regarding maintenance of their property that were notified and have made no attempt to comply with the township ordinance.

Thirdly, he stated that Sunoco Pipeline submitted drawings that where signed and sealed in Ohio and that this was unacceptable that they would need signatures and seals from Pennsylvania.

Lastly, he stated the final inspection was made on Haney Road.

**SOLICITOR:**

Garen Fedeles stated he plans on drafting an ordinance regarding the Act 44 in a good-faith effort to comply with legislation.

He also explained that he and Jeff Frye reviewed the ordinance regarding travel trailers. He suggested the ordinance be amended and in addition to that a Conditional Use application will need to be filed with the township.

**HOST MUNICIPAL INSPECTOR:** Report was not available.

**VISITORS COMMENTS:** Bill Shaffer inquired about the citations regarding the land owners who have not responded to the maintenance letter. Jeff Frye explained that he will file the citation with the magistrates office and they will send a letter to the landowner stating the date of the hearing.

Ron Stidmon stated he is in need of leaves for compost at his farm. He was present to ask the Supervisors for approval to make the Township Building a drop off point for residents to dispose of their leaves. He went on to say that they would provide a dump truck and when it was full, he would dispose of them. Supervisors suggested to Mr. Stidmon he could use the Fire Departments property in the Borough and they agreed to move forward on this matter on a trial basis.

Jim & Pam Ballin and Frances Tyson spoke regarding their neighbor Robbie Summers. Chairman, Chad Crawford stated that the supervisors have been moving forward on this matter and that there will be repercussions if Mr. Summers fails to comply with the ordinance.

Greg Houlette spoke regarding the dust at Tuboscope stating this matter has still not been corrected. Chairman, Chad Crawford stated that the township will contact the manager to see what the status is regarding tarring and chipping the pipe yard.
