

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD
MONDAY, APRIL 11, 2022**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, April 11, 2022 for their regularly scheduled monthly meeting in the Township municipal building at 7:00 P.M.
