

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP  
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD MONDAY, APRIL 11, 2016**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, April 11, 2016 for their regular monthly meeting in the township municipal building at 7:00 P.M.

Chairman, Chad Crawford called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Mike Seiber was present to discuss the storm water issue behind his residence. Ron Stidmon, Shaun McRoberts, Kevin McRoberts, Jeff Frye, Susan Householder and Mike Seiber met Bob Ridzon who is employed with the railroad earlier in the day to see if they could find a solution to the storm water issue behind the Seiber's and Houlette residence. After much discussion, supervisors felt that the land owner, Augustine DeFazio should be contacted to request his permission to have the gas company clear out the existing swale and then perhaps the railroad company would replace the existing pipe that would allow the storm water to drain properly.

Joe Caler presented photos to the board to show them the deployable condition of his neighbor's property. Chad Crawford directed Jeff to forward a violation letter regarding property maintenance to the landowners.
