PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill Shaffer of Oakdale Road shared concern over the lack of disposition over the foreclosure properties located on Oakdale Road. Requested the Township research various methods of intervention.

Rick Boggs of Darlington Road inquired into the process of placing a single wide trailer onto the existing vacant lot that he owns along Darlington Road.

Ron Stidmon of Little Beaver Creek Road shared disappointment over the Connect Beaver County project not including his properties, the expense he would incur to obtain Comcast service at his properties, and the slow pace of the Windstream RDOF project for his properties. Mention was also made of the need for school taxes to be paid on camper rentals within the Township.

Janene Quetot of Big Beaver Borough shared concern over the property next to her parents' property on Black Drive. Reports there is junk and rats at the neighboring property, and that the occupants are running an at home business without proper approval from the Township.

Thomas Newman of Hollow Road shared concerns over his property that has been ordered for demolition.
