

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP

MONDAY, MARCH 9, 2026**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, March 9, 2026 for their regularly scheduled monthly meeting in the Township municipal building at 6:00 P.M.

ITEM 4: Mike Carreon motioned to authorize appropriate Township officials to sign Local Share Account Grant Contract C000097289 accepting the terms and conditions of receiving \$90,399 in funding for purchase of police vehicles. Dave Anderson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

ITEM 5: Mike Carreon motioned to authorize the approval the revisions of the Darlington Township Employee Handbook relevant to paid time off policy. Dave Anderson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
