

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD MONDAY, APRIL 10, 2017**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, April 10, 2017 for their regular monthly meeting in the township municipal building at 7:00 P.M.

Chairman, Chad Crawford called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Comments were made regarding concerns of a pond that could possibly overflow, road repairs and the drainage pipe that was not completed by the railroad tracks near Versitech. There also was a discussion regarding Northwestern school and the proposed new stadium at Blackhawk High School.
