The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, March 11, 2024 for their regularly scheduled monthly meeting in the Township municipal building at 7:00 P.M.

COMMUNICATION:

Discussed Federal, State and Local taxes related to those who received 1099s from Norfolk Southern. Township has requested Norfolk Southern to provide assistance to Township residents should they need to amend their return filings, waiting to hear back.

Federal Appropriations were approved in Bill text and \$3.66 million was awarded to use for a public water project where Darlington Township works in conjunction with Beaver Falls Municipal Authority. The plan is to run water down Route 51, and down Cannelton Road, with no mandatory tap-ins. The project is significantly more expensive that the awarded funds, looking at other ways to fund the project that do not include any debt.
