

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 13, 2012.**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on February 13, 2012 for their regular monthly meeting in the township municipal building at 8:00 P.M.

Chairman Hans Dahlin called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Hans Dahlin motioned, Chad Crawford seconded to approve the January 9, 2012 minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

REPORTS:

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Monthly report was available.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: Monthly report was available.

ROAD DEPARTMENT: Monthly report was available.

ZONING OFFICER: Jeff Frye reported he received a phone call regarding building inspections for the Northwestern School bleachers. He explained that installing the bleachers does not require a zoning permit but that they would need to call the townships building inspector, John Balser.

MUNICIPAL HOST: No report was available.

VISITORS COMMENTS: Present were the following: Joe Caler, Samuel Dssler, Paul M. Dessler and Evelyn Dessler, John Bibbee, Brian Farkas, Amy Dugan, Stacey Brodak and Deb Lambert.

Stacy Brodak introduced herself and Amy Dugan as representatives for Chesapeake Energy. She explained that they were placing proposed well pads on the Bibbee and McRoberts properties in Darlington Township. She further explained that Chesapeake was interested in starting these projects as soon as possible. Solicitor, Garen Fedeles explained the procedure of applying for a Conditional Hearing and the time frame involved.

BUSINESS MEETING

- ITEM # 1 Supervisors to schedule a date for the Chesapeake Conditional Hearing.**
Supervisors scheduled April 9, 2012 at 5:00 for the Chesapeake Conditional Hearing.
- ITEM # 2 Supervisors to review the noise level report regarding tuboscope.**
Chairman, Hans Dahlin stated that the township has received the results from the noise level study regarding NovTuboscope. George Farkus from Conserve Communications & Electronics, Inc. stated that Tuboscope passed with no violations observed.
- ITEM #3 Supervisors to make a motion on approving Rettew Engineering Firm to perform test pits on the pavement thickness and laboratory testing on subgrade conditions.**
Hans Dahlin motioned, John Nicely seconded to approve Rettew Engineering Firm to perform test pits on the pavement thickness and laboratory testing on subgrade conditions contingent upon the following roads being added to the Rettew letter. All excavated material shall be removed. Backfill shall consist of 6 inch layers of compacted 2A limestone. The final 3 inches shall be compacted cold patch black top level to the existing road pavement.
- ITEM #4 Sam Dessler to do a presentation on his Eagle Scout Service Project.**
Sam Dessler explained he needed to complete a Service Project in order to receive his Eagle Scout Badge. He presented different ideas to the Board of Supervisors regarding the park. Supervisors decided on option A of his packet that included picnic tables and grills.
