Bill Shaffer inquired if anything had been done about the abandoned, unsightly properties in the township. Chad Crawford explained the supervisors are working on a way to confront the problem without singling out one resident while also insuring that we are complying with the ordinance.

Bill Shaffer inquired about the bend on Enon Road regarding the parking issue. Chad Crawford explained that Kevin McRoberts has made several attempts to contact the owner to discuss a possible solution to her parking arrangement and hasn't been able to reach her.

Secondly, Mr. Shaffer expressed concerns about the speeders on Oakdale Road, he explained that Bob Caler can not see pulling out of his driveway if a vehicle is coming around the bend. Bill suggested possibly a traffic mirror be placed on Bob Caler's property to assist him in pulling out of his driveway.
