The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, December 8, 2025 for their regularly scheduled monthly meeting in the Township municipal building at 6:00 P.M.

Mike Carreon, Chairman of the Board called the meeting to order at 6:01 P.M. and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Glenda Tetemanza of Darlington Borough requested that the Township pursue a burning ordinance and remain vigilant of the operations at Brickyard in the Township.

**TOWNSHIP MINUTES:**

Mike Carreon motioned and Dave Anderson seconded to approve the Minutes for the November 2025 Township meeting as presented. Motion carried.

**TOWNSHIP TREASURER'S REPORT:**

Mike Carreon motioned and Dave Anderson seconded to approve the Treasurer's report for November 2025 as presented. Motion carried.

**BILL LIST:**

Mike Carreon motioned and Dave Anderson seconded to authorize the payment of vendors on the December 2025 bill list as presented. Motion carried.

**REPORTS:**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT:** Monthly report of service calls was presented. Information was shared on the continuing selection process of a new tanker truck to purchase with a federal grant that was received.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT:** Monthly report was available for review, and discussion reviewed the need for upgrading some of the existing radios due to the County's new digital dispatch system. Discussion regarding purchasing a new police vehicle to replace the 12 year old vehicle.

**ROAD MAINTENANCE:** Monthly report was available for review including discussion regarding the ongoing wait to receive their new truck.

**ENGINEER:** Report included information on the letter sent to US Electric regarding the final expectations and bond requirements of the proposed solar farm. Permits with the State and County are still pending for this project.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT:** Report provided by Township Secretary regarding 158 Essie Street and 513 Fifth Street.

**ZONING OFFICER:** Report provided by Township Engineer/Zoning Officer including: concerns regarding the potential use violations of 101 Aid Drive and his attempts to contact the owner's attorney; concerns regarding the potential use violations of 4070 Constitution and the letter sent to the property owner.

**SOLICITOR:** Provided feedback on considering a data center ordinance and the steps the Supervisors could initiate to begin that process.

**GRANT WRITING:** Report was provided by Township Secretary including the postponement of award determination for pending LSA grant. Additional plans to potentially apply for more State funding to finish some upgrades to the McRoberts Park were also discussed.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**ITEM 1:** Mike Carreon motioned accept the Proposed 2026 Operating Budget of the Darlington Township Volunteer Fire Department including both direct and indirect contributions from Darlington Township's General Fund at an estimated \$80,000 with additional to be determined direct contributions to the Darlington Township Volunteer Fire Department's Capital Reserve Account. Dave Anderson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**ITEM 2:** Mike Carreon motioned to accept the resignation of part-time Police Sergeant Ronald Leindecker effective November 15, 2025. Dave Anderson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**ITEM 3:** Mike Carreon motioned to Motion to promote part-time Patrolman Jesse Richman to Part-time Sergeant at a payrate of \$24.35 effective November 30, 2025. Dave Anderson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**ITEM 4:** Mike Carreon motioned to issue official notification to effected Industrial Park Businesses of the Decommissioning of Non-Community, Non-Transient Pubic Water Supply (PWS ID No. 5040334) owned and operated by Darlington Township with Reclassification to Fire Suppression Use Only System effective May 31, 2026. Dave Anderson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**ITEM 5:** Mike Carreon motioned to adopt the 2026 General Fund Budget as presented with **no real estate tax increase**, and a millage rate remaining at 1.508. Dave Anderson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**ADJOURN:**

There being no further business Mike Carreon motioned; Tom Blinkiewicz seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Time 6:20 pm
