

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2015**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, September 14, 2015 for their regular monthly meeting in the township municipal building at 8:00 P.M.

Chairman, Chad Crawford called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Comments were made regarding the maintenance of properties, the dangerous bend on Oakdale Road, a suggestion was made to the Chairman announcing the agenda to the public prior to the business part of meeting, the conduct of residents at the township meetings, railroad, safety of employees, traffic signal at Cannelton and Constitution Boulevard and a request to dismantle Sylvania Bridge.

Greg Dillon was present stated he has replaced and updated the pipe regarding the storm water running off his property.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Chad Crawford motioned, Shaun McRoberts seconded to approve the August 10, 2015 minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

REPORTS:

FIRE DEPARTMENT: President, Brian Farkus stated that the donation letters have been sent out to the township residents and also they are holding their 5K and Open House on October 10, 2015. Monthly report was available.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: Chief Al Falauri warned the residents that there have been several burglaries in Darlington and also in Big Beaver Borough. Monthly report was available.

ROAD MAINTENANCE: Monthly report was available.

ZONING OFFICER/ ENGINEER: Engineer, Jeff Frye stated that there are two hearings scheduled in September regarding property maintenance. He also mentioned the well testing permit has been delayed and all the repairs have been completed on Enon Road.

SOLICITORS : Garen Fedeles stated that Chesapeake has signed the Agreement in assisting in the repairs regarding Enon Road.

HOST MUNICIPAL INSPECTOR: Monthly report was not available.

BUSINESS MEETING:

- ITEM #1 Michael Simmons from Penn Dot will be present to discuss a program Penn Dot has to offer.**
Mr. Simmons explained that basically Penn Dot offers a program that Penn Dot and the local government will share services. He further explained that the two parties will voice what each one is interested in having and together will decide on a dollar value. No action was taken.

Chad Crawford motioned, John Nicely seconded to approve purchasing the Road Salt through the COG for the 2015-2016 year. The bid was awarded to Morton Salt for the amount of \$76.93 per ton. Motion carried unanimously.
- ITEM # 6 Supervisors to approve the purchasing of Cinder through the COG for the 2015-2016 year.**
Chad Crawford motioned, John Nicely seconded to approve the purchasing of Cinders through the COG for the 2015-2016 year. The bid was awarded to AR Oliastro Inc. for the amount of \$12.25 per ton.
- ITEM# 7 Supervisors to make a motion to approve Michael Navolio placing a temporary mobile home on his property.**
Chad Crawford motioned, Shaun McRoberts seconded to approve Michael Navolio placing a temporary mobile home on his property contingent upon an agreement stating the mobile home after 90 days of being vacated will be removed. Motion carried unanimously.
- ITEM # 8 Supervisors to make a motion to commit up to \$4,034.58 towards the development of the townships playground if a grant is secured.**

Chad Crawford motioned, John Nicely seconded to committing up to \$4,034.58 towards the townships playground if a grant is secured. Motion carried unanimously.
