

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2019**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, September 9, 2019 for their regular monthly meeting in the township municipal building at 7:00 P.M.

Chairman, Chad Crawford called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Comments were made regarding speeding on Darlington Road, a property maintenance issue on Little Beaver Road, ditches on Oakdale Road, and a fence and possible chemical spray issue between neighbors on Black Drive.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Chad Crawford motioned and Shaun McRoberts seconded to approve the August 12, 2019 Township Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF THE WORK SESSION MINUTES: Chad Crawford motioned and Shaun McRoberts seconded to approve the September 3, 2019 Work Session Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

REPORTS:

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Monthly report was not available.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: Monthly report was available.

ROAD MAINTENANCE: Monthly report was available.

ZONING OFFICER/ ENGINEER: Jeff Frye stated that a second letter had been sent certified mail to the resident on Black Drive giving 15 days notice to comply, then a citation will be filed. A zoning permit was issued for changes to a cell phone tower. He commented that the Industrial Park Water Line project is going well. A fire hydrant was discovered to have a broken stem and it will be replaced as an extra to the project. He submitted Rudzik Excavating, Inc's Estimate for Partial Payment #1 in the amount of \$107,317.61. He has reviewed it and recommends the Township make payment.

SOLICITORS : Nothing to report.

RECREATION BOARD: Lori O'Connell stated that a Paddle Party will be held on Saturday, September 21, 2019 at noon at the Township Building. The recreation board is also working on plans to do some community outreach in the month of November and start a welcome wagon for new residents.

BUSINESS MEETING:

ITEM #1 Supervisors to discuss opening an account for replacing police vehicles as needed.
The supervisors requested that Brandon Eberle draft a resolution for a capital fund for them to review. No formal action taken at this time.

ITEM #2 Supervisors to make a motion to approve the 2020 Non-Uniform and Police Pension MMO.
Chad Crawford motioned and Shaun McRoberts seconded to approve the 2020 Non-Uniform and Police Pension MMO. Motion carried unanimously.

OUTSTANDING BILLS: Chad Crawford motioned and Shaun McRoberts seconded to pay the outstanding bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Chad Crawford motioned and Ron Stidmon seconded to transfer \$107,317.61 from the Water Account to the General Fund to pay Rudzik Excavating, Inc.'s Estimate for Partial Payment #1. Motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER REPORT: Chad Crawford motioned and Shaun McRoberts seconded to accept the treasurer's report. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business Chad Crawford motioned and Shaun McRoberts seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Time 7:50.
