

**MINUTES OF THE DARLINGTON TOWNSHIP  
SUPERVISORS MEETING HELD MONDAY, JUNE 12, 2017**

The Darlington Township Supervisors met on Monday, June 12, 2017 for their regular monthly meeting in the township municipal building at 7:00 P.M.

Chairman, Chad Crawford called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by the Lord's Prayer.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Ken O'Neil spoke about a water runoff issue on Haney Road. Chad Crawford said the engineer and road master can take a look at this area. Comments were made about the fire department mutual aid agreements, immobilized vehicles, mowing at McChesney and Haney Road, cut grass clogging a drain on Oakdale Road and a sinkhole on Oakdale Road.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:** Chad Crawford motioned, Ron Stidmon seconded to approve the May 8, 2017 Township Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

**REPORTS:**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT:** President, Brian Farkas stated that Darlington Days was well attended. He thanked the Police Department and Road Department for their help.

**ROAD MAINTENANCE:** Monthly report was available.

**ZONING OFFICER/ ENGINEER:** Jeff Frye stated that he is waiting for a hearing date concerning the Bucklew property. Comments were made about the property maintenance at 100 Cannelton Road and 340 Rohrman Road. Mr. Frye has received a request from Dollar General to move some trees from the Route 51 side of the property to the Cannelton Road side to ensure vehicles have a clear view. It was suggested that they plant shrubs to still provide a barrier on the Route 51 side.

**ITEM #6 Supervisors to make a motion to approve the Cog Bid awarding Russell Standard Corp the CRS 2 Liquid Asphalt.**

**ITEM #7 Supervisors to have a preliminary discussion regarding the Township Burning Ordinance.**
